

Medical check -up for newly hired staff and faculties

■ How to make an appointment for a medical checkup and answer the web questionnaire

You need to make a reservation by yourself on the website. Log in “マイハンダイ <https://my.osaka-u.ac.jp/>” with your personal ID and PW. Click “職員健康診断”, then click “**雇入れ時健康診断/Medical check-up for newly hired staff**”. Choose the date and time you wish to take check-up at least a day in advance. After completing the reservation, please continue to complete the web questionnaire.

You can change or cancel the reservation yourself, but you cannot change it on the day of the event. In that case, please contact us by phone.

■ Information (about an hour for your check-up.)

<Your belongings>

- ・ QR code (you will receive a completion email with a QR code after completing the web questionnaire)
- ・ T-shirt for X-ray examination, hair clip if necessary (see note ⑤)

<Check-up menu>

- ◎Interview (Medical history, Lifestyle) ◎Doctor’s consultation(subjective and objective symptoms)
- ◎Height, weight, waist measurements ◎Vision test ◎Blood pressure ◎Urine analyses
- ◎Chest X-ray examination◎Blood test (anemia, liver function, lipid profile, glucose metabolism, kidney function, level of uric acid) ◎Electrocardiogram test ◎Audiometry

■ Note

※For those who take check-up for newly rehired staff are not required to take regular check-up for staff.

- ① **Please be punctual.** If you are late, you may not take medical check-up unless you make a new reservation.
- ② **You cannot take breakfast, any food or drinks** except water and your daily medicine.
- ③ Those who engaged in specified work should answer [For those Engaged in Specified Work] in the Medical Questionnaire without fail.
 - ※Existing/New staff handling radioisotopes/radiation also needs to answer this questions as the advance RI examination.
 - ※If you have any concerns as engaging in specified work, please tell us about it when you visit HaCC.
- ④ If you are on your period, tell the staff in the urinalysis section.
- ⑤ **Your clothes:** We won’t rent T-shirts during checkup. Please wear clothing that you can remove quickly. For X-ray examination, only a plain T-shirt is allowed to wear. Do not wear one-piece dress, stockings, tights, and boots. `Also, remove any jewels, accessories, metal fittings, elastic strings, collars, ties, and any thick materials.
- ⑥ Parking lot is not available at Health and Counseling Center.

◇Information about additional medical checkup supported by NPO [PAID TESTS]

1. Prostate-Specific Antigen (PSA) Test [Fee: 2,000 yen] Recommended test for men 50yrs and over 50yrs
2. ABC Test (Stomach cancer risk) [Fee: 4,000 yen] Recommended test for 35yrs and over 35yrs
3. Fecal occult blood reaction test (colorectal cancer screening) [Fee: 1,000 yen or 2,000 yen] Recommended test for 40yrs and over 40yrs.

If you wish to have any of the above tests, please ask at the reception desk on the day of your health checkup with cash. ※Those who wish to take these tests, please request us for it directly when you come to take your check-up. We only accept cash, please bring cash with you.

What to Wear

① We won't rent T-shirts or hair clips.

② You need to take off your shoes for body measurement.
Avoid wearing boots/trekking shoes.

③ We attach electrodes directly to your ankles with an ECG.
Do not wear pantyhose/tights.

④ Please wear a plain T-shirt for the chest X-ray or clothes easy to take off from your upper body.
