1: What you should do **before** the checkup

 - All students are required to take the web questionnaire in advance. *To login these systems, use your personal ID and PW.

Urine test

- You can get the urine container "Pee-Pole", at your faculty/department from the beginning of April. You cannot use our restroom to collect your urine sample. Collect your first morning urine on your checkup day.
- If you are having your period, tell the staff when you submit your urine sample.

What to wear to the checkup

- Avoid wearing boots/accessories to proceed the checkup smoothly.
- We won't lend T-shirts/hair clips/bags. *Read the attached notice carefully.

3: Result / Certificate

- The certificate of Student Annual Checkup 2023 will be available from Fri, December 1 at any branch of Health Care Center or automatic certificate issuing machine. You can also check your result on KOAN website. If you need your health checkup report as soon as possible, please contact us using the contact information below.
- The certificate won't be issued if you didn't take the annual checkup 2023.

4: Others

- Taking checkup is mandatory for students of Osaka University based on regulations of Osaka University
- Graduate students and Research Students who work at other institutes can submit the checkup certificate issued from your workplace as a substitute for your annual checkup.
- This checkup is for the 2023 academic year; for the 2024 academic year, students are required to take the annual checkup in April, 2024.
- We can give you a proof of taking a checkup during classes if you need it. You can use it as an excuse of missing classes.
